Each concert becomes a journey through space and time. They compose their own music, drawing inspiration from traditional, classical, and pop music, which they blend with electro sounds.

Through their familial complicity and the unique harmony of their instruments, they make each concert a moment rich in emotion. Together, they create an intimacy with the audience while delivering the scale of a large-scale show.

Since 2022, the JenliSisters have performed more than 200 times a year in various projects, including Celtic, classical, and electro music, as well as children's shows.
